Columbia County Children's Health Home Care Coordination Agencies

What is a Health Home (HH)?

A Health Home is not a place. It is a Medicaid service that can help support the child/youth and their family. A Health Home Care Manager works as a team with the child/youth, their family and service providers to help a child/youth receive the care and services they need to stay healthy.

Health Homes are for Children and Youth Who May:

- Go to the Emergency Room or hospital a lot;
- Have behavior issues that impact their daily routine (i.e. suspended from school);
- Have many difficult medical needs;
- Miss school a lot when they're sick or having behavior issues;
- Have a recent psychiatric admission;
- Have a parent or caregiver who feels stressed or overwhelmed;
- Have no supports or difficulty connecting to needed professionals or services

Who Is Eligible?

The child/youth must be under the age of 21 and have:

- Current Medicaid or be able to qualify for Medicaid, and;
- Chronic health, medical, and/or mental health conditions which need a doctor's care
